Re: People v. Isiah Brown

On September 15, 2017, in Department 2 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Daniel Healy, the jury found the defendant, Isiah Brown, guilty of violating Penal Code Section 273.5(a), Felony Domestic Violence and Penal Code Section 211, Robbery. On January 12, 2016, upon returning to the home of the defendant's mother to pick up her daughter she had in common with the defendant, the victim was assaulted by the defendant. The defendant pulled up to the home and approached the passenger side of the victim's car. He opened the door and began repeatedly punching the victim in her head. The defendant's mother attempted to stop the defendant from hitting the victim. The defendant then took the victim's keys by force causing injury to her finger. He then fled the scene with the keys, which she did not get back for days.



The victim testified at trial about the assault on January 12, and past incidents of domestic violence that occurred in their relationship. The defendant is scheduled to be sentenced on October 21, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.

Officer Ryan McLaughlin of the Vallejo Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Brittany Armstrong and Shamar Lewis was the victim advocate.
