Re: People v. Tommie Bolts

On September 26, 2017, in Department 2 of the Solano County Superior Court, before the Honorable Arvid Johnson, the jury found the defendant, Tommie Bolts, guilty of Receiving Stolen Property, Motor Vehicle, in violation of Penal Code Section 496d(a). On July 12, 2017, in the City of Vallejo, the defendant was driving a 2000 Honda Civic that had been reported stolen on July 6, 2017. Vallejo Police Officer Jason Bahou was on patrol and ran a license plate check on the Civic, and confirmed that it was reported stolen in Vallejo. Officer Bahou conducted a traffic stop and the defendant was arrested. Officer Bahou noticed the car was running without a key in the ignition. He recovered a folding pocket knife from the driver's side floorboard. The defendant admitted using the knife as a key to start the car. He is scheduled to be sentenced on October 25, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 2.



Officer Jason Bahou of the Vallejo Police Department investigated the case. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Judy Ycasas.
