Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Waterfront and Boater Access project includes the Day Use Restroom structure/facility area (boat launch and the existing path that connects the day use side to the nature center area). It is in desperate need of ADA access updates. The existing concrete waterfront access area around the restroom (specifically the Women's restroom) is too steep and does not meet current ADA standards. The project at the campground (West-side of park) will also be replacing the existing seawall that is rotting and has currently failed in several locations, causing sections of the day use area to erode, causing a potential hazard to the public. Sheet pilings will be installed adjacent to the existing sea wall that is being removed to prevent materials from falling into the waterway. The project is removing existing non-compliant concrete walkways with compliant ADA walkways.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The project will be removing existing non-ADA compliant concrete paving and replace with new ADA compliant pathway and flat-work. The new flat-work will be installed at existing locations with no trees or bushes will affected. The project will also replace two rotting seawalls and replace with new sheet piles. Affected area is approximately 4,685 sf on the day use (East) and 3,436 sf on the campground side (West). The permanent impacts are the replacement of the rotting seawalls and installing new sheet piles. The calculated impacts are 2,691 cubic feet on the day use and 1,003 cubic feet on the campground.
