Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Solano Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Composting Site Information (RCSI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Potrero Hills Compostable Materials Handling Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of Solano.

Description of Changes

The RCSI amendment addresses the following changes:

- Relocate the composting facility boundary within landfill's permitted boundary. This change will not increase nor decrease the permitted acreage of 22 acres and the compost facility will remain in the central portion of the landfill commonly known as Phase I.
- Update Figure 2 (Site Plan) to detail the Greenwaste/Woodwaste processing area and to reflect the change in the boundary of the Composting Operation within the portion of the landfill's permitted boundary commonly known as Phase I.
- Update Figure 3 (Layout and General Dimensions) to detail the Greenwaste/Woodwaste processing area and to reflect the change in the boundary of the Composting Operation within the portion of the landfill's permitted boundary commonly known as Phase I.

LEA's Determination

Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations, section 21665(c), the LEA reviewed the application and determined that the proposed change is consistent with State Minimum Standards, is consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, and does not conflict with the existing Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The LEA approved the amendment on April 24, 2014.
