District Attorney Donald A. du Bain announced today that his office has charged Anthony Lemar Jones, age 32, with one count of murder in violation of Penal Code section 187(a). In addition, the defendant is charged with three allegations considered under California law to be special circumstances:

- (1) That the murder was committed during the commission of a kidnapping in violation of Penal Code section 190.2(a)(17)(C).
- (2) That the murder was committed during the commission of a rape in violation of Penal Code section 190.2(a)(17)(B).
- (3) That the murder was committed during the commission of a lewd or lascivious act upon a child under the age of 14 years in violation of Penal Code section 190.2(a)(17)(E).

If found guilty of murder, a finding in favor of any of the special circumstances would subject the defendant to a penalty of either life in prison without the possibility of parole or the death penalty.

The defendant declined to enter a plea to the charges today and his appointed counsel asked instead that his arraignment occur on February 21, 2013, at 8:30 a.m., in Department 17, in Fairfield. The special circumstances allegations require that the defendant be held in jail without bail.
