Solano WIC Program Facts

- Services to 11,200 women, infants and children each month
- Approximately 800 individuals are enrolled each month
- There are 4 main sites and 2 satellite sites



WIC Program Eligibility

- Income up to 185 percent of poverty
 - Example \$3,184 per month for a family of 4
- Pregnant, breastfeeding and new mothers, infants and children up to the 5th birthday
- California resident



WIC Program Services

- Individual and group
- Newest adult learning methods

 - 92% of infants and children have health coverage
