INFORMATION RELEASE 03/09/15 SUSPECT ARRESTED AFTER TAKING PHOTOS OF MINORS IN LOCKER ROOM

On Saturday March 7, 2015 just after 1:30 p.m., the Solano County Sheriff's Office received a call regarding an Asian adult male who was seen in the female locker room at Solano Community College. At the time of the report, there was a swim meet at the college pool and the female locker room was being used by minor females participating in the event.

The caller, who was the parent of one of the female swimmers, informed dispatch her daughter had observed the man in the locker room filming minor females using his cellular telephone. The daughter pointed out the male to her mother and the mother began to chase the man while yelling for assistance from other parents. Several other parents then began to chase the suspect and eventually cornered him in the gym lobby and kept him there until deputies arrived.

Deputies arrived and detained the suspect, who was identified as 33 year old Jason Ray Paner of Sacramento. After interviewing the victim and several witnesses, Solano County Sheriff's Office Detectives were called to the location to conduct the investigation.

After the initial investigation, Paner was arrested and transported to the Solano County Sheriff's Office to be interviewed. At that time, a search warrant was also written for Paner's cellular telephone. Several images of minor females were discovered on the phone that appeared to have been taken inside the Solano Community College locker room during the time of the swim meet. A search warrant was later served at Paner's residence in Sacramento and other electronic devices were seized at that time.

Paner was booked for felony possession of obscene matter depicting a minor and burglary. Paner was charged with the burglary, as detectives believe Paner entered the locker room with the intent to photograph the minors. Paner's bail was set at \$20,000.00 and prior to 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, Paner posted bail and was released from the Solano County Jail.
