#### C. Substance Abuse Administrator's Report – Andrew Williamson:

- 1115B Waiver the State will be working with Phase 1 Counties on how to implement the waiver; Solano County is part of Phase 1 along with the rest of the Bay Area Counties
  - Three things needed to apply for the Waiver are ASAM Training (completed), Contract with BOS (in progress), Application (in progress)
  - o Rates are still in need to be negotiated with DHCS (State would like to fund it a per user per month basis)
- County is currently in hiring process for two Licensed Mental Health Clinicians to fill SMART (CalWORKS) and SBIRT positions
- Two Clinical Services Associates in the Center for Positive Change is currently in process to change their classifications to MFTI
- Rosewood Transitional Housing in Vallejo is closing down since Youth & Family was the one running it

## B. Provider Presentation: Women's Reentry Achievement Program (WRAP), Patty Ayala, WRAP Case Manager

• The WRAP is a federally granted program since 2011. It was overseen by the Reentry Council, which has since dissipated. The program now needs a new oversight committee to oversee the program. It is a jail based program and has served over 360 women. It provides a twenty-five page assessment, evidence based curriculum, parenting classes, case management inside and outside the jail. This is the final year for the program, and will soon be completed around September – December, unless another funding can be used.

Since the program is doing so well, the WRAP was used as an example for a gender specific program in the Women's Foundation of California Principles and recommendations for gender-responsive approaches for criminal justice reform. It is also the only 1 out of 7 programs funded by the Second Chance Act Grant, which will be used as the national model for an all women program.
