ARTICLE XI. PENALTIES

Sec. 4-170. Generally

- (a) Except for section 4-73, and notwithstanding chapter 1, section 1-7 of the County Code, any violation of this chapter shall be an infraction. Where a specific penalty is not provided for an infraction violation, any such violation shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars. Every day any violation of this chapter shall continue, shall constitute a separate offense.
- (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) above, any violation of this chapter is a misdemeanor if a defendant has been convicted of, admitted to, or pled no contest to one or more violations of this chapter, and such prior determination is admitted to by the defendant or alleged in the accusatory pleading.
