Solano County indends to conduct a community planning process for the MHSA Innovation Component that combines focus groups, community meetings for both the general public and specific populations or interest groups, and surveys to identify issues of interest to the community. The identified issues will be prioritized through a community consensus building process. A working group will be established to develop innovative solutions to the highest priority issue.
