Notice of Community Meetings

PROPOSED first amendment to the Countywide Siting Element of the Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan

The County of Solano will hold community meetings to give the public an opportunity to provide input on the proposed first amendment to the Countywide Siting Element (CSE) of the Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan (CIWMP) mandated under California's Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989, or Assembly Bill (AB) 939.

To implement AB 939, counties are required to maintain adequacy of the CIWMP to ensure annual achievement of the 50 percent solid waste diversion goal, as now calculated on a per capita disposal target under Senate Bill (SB) 1016 passed in 2007.

The CIWMP identifies the goals and objectives of the cities and County of Solano to address the solid waste, recyclables and organic waste management conditions generated by our residential, agricultural, school and business communities. It is comprised of five elements: CSE, Non-Disposal Facility Element, Source Reduction and Recycling Element, Household Hazardous Waste Element and Summary Plan. The adequacy of a CIWMP is determined by the state's Department of Resources Recovery and Recycling, or CalRecycle.

The CSE describes the solid waste disposal facilities used by the cities and County of Solano and provides analysis to demonstrate the minimum 15-year disposal capacity required.
