DID YOU KNOW?

NATIONALLY:

1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men have been victims of physical violence by an intimate partner within their lifetime.

In the United States, more than 4 children die from child abuse and neglect on a daily basis. Over 70% of these children are below the age of 3.

1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys will be sexually abused before they turn 18 years old. On an average, approximately 500 women a day are raped or sexually assaulted in the United States. Annually, rape costs the U.S. more than any other crime (\$127 billion).

Approximately 1 in 10 Americans aged 60+ have experienced some form of elder abuse; with estimates ranging as high as 5 million elders who are abused each year.

SOLANO COUNTY:

More than 2,880 domestic violence calls for help were received by law enforcement.

Over 3,400 referrals were received by Child Welfare Services.

More than 1,100 referrals were received by Older and Disabled Adult Services.
